
Mr. Guo Gan is the first Chinese folk musician and erhu player to receive the prestigious French honor of Chevalier de l'Ordre des Arts et des Lettres. His extensive career has taken him to over 100 countries, where he has performed in more than 3,000 concerts and released over 100 albums globally. He has composed scores for over 70 films, including notable titles such as *Kung Fu Panda 3*, *The New Shaolin Temple*, and *Gallic Heroes – The Central Empire*.

Throughout his career, Mr. Guo Gan has collaborated with renowned artists, including pianist Lang Lang, conductor Yvan Cassar, jazz violinist Didier Lockwood, composer Gabriel Yared, music producer Hans Zimmer, and pianist Jean–François Zygel. He has also worked with prominent figures in the music industry, such as Belgian pop star Stromae and French rock artist Matthieu Chedid, as well as Dubai singer Sami Yusuf.

Mr. Guo has performed in some of the world's most prestigious concert halls and frequently collaborates with symphony orchestras internationally. In addition to his performance work, he is an active composer for film and television.
